

CEMETERY RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Any and all permanent improvements, modifications or alterations of cemetery lots (including installation of headstones) must first be approved in writing by the Cemetery Board. The Cemetery Board shall furnish application forms to the public for this purpose, which shall be available at the Clerk and Recorder's Office, Powder River County Courthouse.

2. Any and all types, designs and styles of headstones, whether standing or flat, may be installed on a cemetery lot provided that it be placed on a cement base with a six inch (6") flange, so that the caretaker may mow over edge of the base.

3. Any and all flowers, artificial wreaths or artificial flowers must be removed from the cemetery within two (2) weeks after being placed there, so that the grass may be properly mowed and other maintenance can be completed.

4. Permanent flower planters and containers are permitted if approved prior to installation, and if set below ground level so that they may be covered by the caretaker so he may mow over them.

5. Any and all trees and shrubs must be planted only around the perimeter of the cemetery and not near individual graves, and prior, written permission must first be obtained.

6. Any headstones, flowers, trees, shrubs, flower planters, or other objects placed or installed at the cemetery in violation of these rules shall be removed by the cemetery board. Further, the party(ies) responsible for such unauthorized actions shall be responsible for the costs of removing any and all such items.

7. Anyone who has questions about these rules is directed to contact the County Commissioners or the cemetery Board members before taking any action.

8. The purpose of adopting these regulations is to promote the safety of the cemetery caretaker and visitors, to ensure that the cemetery may be properly maintained, to improve the design and appearances of the cemetery, to provide shade trees in appropriate locations, and develop the cemetery in a uniform and controlled manner.
