

Outdoor Horse Activities for Powder River County 2020

The sponsor/host individual or organization will include a notification as part of their public information that people cannot attend if they are ill for any reason.

Spectators—Social distancing is recommended in groups of any size. When visiting with others maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet when possible. The use of face masks is recommended.

Concessions—Available in ‘grab and go’ items. There will be no use of community condiments. No refillable beverages.

There is a bathroom facility at the fairgrounds, and you MUST wash hands after using the bathroom. Contestants are encouraged to use their own trailer bathrooms. Hand sanitizer will be available on the grounds, and people are encouraged to wash hands frequently.

Vulnerable participants come to participate at their own risk, as do their parents/guardians and spectators. These vulnerable people are encouraged to take extra precautions, such as wearing a face covering (bandana or mask) when in close proximity to other people.

Limit the number of people around roping boxes and bucking chutes to rodeo staff, parents and participants. No more than one person at the office window at a time unless you are families. Keep spacing to more than 6’ when in line.

If these rules are not followed, you and/or the contestant will be asked to leave the rodeo grounds.

These rules are in place to maintain a healthy community and sport. We want you to know that our organization is taking these steps to show respect and responsibility and we expect you to do the same.

The sponsor/host individual or organization of the activity will abide by the current COVID-19 guidelines established by the State of Montana, as well as the guidelines outlined in this plan established by the Powder River County Public Health Department and approved by the Powder River County Health Officer.
