1. The Fairboard reserves the right to refuse any application for exhibit space.
2. Exhibitors CANNOT sublet their contracted space, without the direct permission of the Fairboard.
3. No support vehicles are allowed in the contracted space.
4. BOOTH RULES: Exhibitors must provide their own tables/chairs, signs/banners, and decorate and/or fix booths at their own expense. Exhibitors must provide their own extension cords, and they MUST meet safety requirements. Exhibits must be kept within the boundaries established.
5. If an exhibitor is unable to fulfill their contract, please notify the Extension Office at 436-2424, by July 23, 2025.
