

MUDDY PIG WRESTLING INSTRUCTIONS

- Team starts against side of round pen opposite of the pig entrance, with one hand on fence. When whistle blows, the team has 1.5 minutes (90 seconds) to go catch pig and gently put in the center tub. When completed, or if time runs out, team helps get the pig back to the trailer.
- Tub must not be moved from the center of the ring.
- Footwear, shirt, and long pants are recommended for safety.
- Pig picking for each team is random, although adult teams will get the largest pigs and PeeWee teams, the smallest.
- The percentage of prize money will be decided by number of contestants in each class.
- Costumes aren't required, but the best costumed team will receive a cash prize.
- Unnecessary rough treatment/abuse of the pigs may result in disqualification. (No pulling ears, tail, kicking, or hitting pigs.)
- Bare hands are the only tool to be used for catching pigs. Please no gloves or other objects.
- The number of teams in each category will be dependent upon the weight of and the number of pigs available.
- Please hose off after competing to avoid spreading the mess.
